Professor Hiroshi Egusa is the Vice Director of Tohoku University Hospital and Director of the Liaison Center for Innovative Dentistry at Tohoku University. He received his DDS (1998) and PhD (2002) degrees from Hiroshima University, and worked in the Department of Oral Microbiology at the University of Hong Kong in 1999. He was awarded a postdoctoral fellowship by the Japanese government for regenerative medicine research at UCLA in 2002-2004. In 2004, he became an Assistant Professor in the Department of Fixed Prosthodontics at Osaka University. In 2014, he was appointed as Professor and Chair in the Division of Molecular and Regenerative Prosthodontics at Tohoku University. He is a board-certified prosthodontist of the Japan Prosthodontic Society. He has received several international awards, including 1st place for the IADR Edward Hatton Award (2002), 1st place for the IADR Arthur Frechette Award (2004), and the IADR Distinguished Scientist Award (Young Investigator Award: 2012).
