The Future of Materials in Prosthodontics

Abstract

In this presentation we will review what has been achieved with contemporary prosthodontic and implant materials, before introducing the rationale for new materials and what new biomaterials are under development

Biography

Owen Addison is currently Professor of Oral Rehabilitation at King's College London and a specialist in Prosthodontics. He qualified as a dentist from the University of Birmingham in 2001, gained his PhD in Biomaterials in 2007 from the same institution, and completed the 5-year specialist clinical in 2012. Appointed as a Lecturer at the University of Birmingham in 2007, he became Senior Lecturer and honorary Consultant in Restorative Dentistry 2012, and in 2015 was promoted to Chair in Applied Biomaterials. In 2016 he took up the position as the ADA&C Endowed Chair in Oral Health Translational Research at the University of Alberta in Canada where he spent 3 years, before returning to the UK in 2019. Owen combines a specialist clinical activity in Prosthodontics with a well-established research programme in biomaterials and medical device development.
