Title

Implant Supported Full-Arch Solutions: Current Fixed & Removable Options

Abstract

Edentulism is prevalent in many parts of the world and removable prostheses have traditionally been used for its management with several limitations. As implant and digital dentistry advancements occur, improvements towards implant retained removable prostheses have changed the way we treat the edentulous population. Despite the higher initial costs, those prostheses lead to higher oral health-related quality of life while they are still more affordable compared to other implant supported treatment alternatives.

This presentation will review the contemporary full-arch fixed and removable implant solutions with a focus on the prosthetically driven surgical treatment planning and prosthetic sequencing of implant supported removable prostheses. Clinical cases with different attachment systems incorporating fully digital workflow will be presented. Treatment sequence with appropriate as well as inadequate planning will be reviewed as a learning tool for future success.

Biography

Dr. Eva Anadioti is an Associate Professor of Clinical Restorative Dentistry at the University of Pennsylvania School of Dental Medicine and the Founding and current Director of the Advanced Education Program in Prosthodontics. She received her Certificate in Prosthodontics and Master's degree from the University of Iowa College of Dentistry and then completed a surgical implant fellowship at the University of North Carolina School of Dentistry. Dr. Anadioti is a Diplomate of the American Board of Prosthodontics, a Director at the American College of Prosthodontists Education Foundation Board and the Prosthodontic Commissioner at the Commission on Dental Accreditation. She has publications in peer-reviewed journals, has presented her work at university and professional conferences worldwide and has received awards both locally and nationally.
