**Title**

The Ebb and Flow of Maxillofacial Prosthetic Reconstruction Trends

**Abstract**

Patients with defects of the jaws and face bring about significant challenges to the treatment team. The approach of sequencing and synergy from advanced techniques puts patients at a tremendous advantage when assembled in these teams. This lecture briefly presents these approaches to incorporate into present day strategies.

**Biography**

Thomas Salinas is Professor and Chair of Dentistry at the Mayo Clinic, where his time is dedicated to rehabilitation of patients with complex care needs. He has authored over 90 publications related to prosthodontics and interdisciplinary care. His research interests are biomaterial behavior and clinical outcome studies. He is past program director for advanced prosthodontics and has leadership roles within the clinical practice and department. He is a fellow of the ACP, Past President of AAMP and Fellow of The Academy of Prosthodontics and a Diplomate of the American Board of Prosthodontics. A native of New Orleans, he was educated at Louisiana State University Health Science Center and MD Anderson Cancer Center.
